This Directorate is pleased to approve you to perform the functions of medical practitioners in accordance with Section 4 of Merchant Shipping (Medical Examination) Rules 2000. Your name has been placed on the panel of this Directorate and shall be displayed on the DGS Website. This approval is valid subject to the following conditions:

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
1. The medical examination of seafarers shall be strictly conducted in accordance with provisions of Merchant Shipping (Medical Examination) Rules 2000 and DGS orders/Notices issued from time to time.

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2. Periodical half yearly returns shall be forwarded to the Directorate by 15th of January and 15th of July. (as per enclosed format)
3. You shall maintain following list of updated publications at your clinic for reference purposes.
 - a. International Health Regulations, WHO Publication;
 - b. Vaccination Certificate requirements and health advice for International travel, in accordance with International health regulations;
 - c. Merchant Shipping Act 1958;
 - d. M.S.(Medical Examination) Rules, 2000;
 - e. M.S.(Medical, Medical Stores & Appliances) Rules, 1994;
 - f. M. S. Crew Accommodation Rules 1960 as amended;
 - g. Indian Ports Act 1908, as amended;
 - h. Indian Port Health Rule 1989;
 - i. International Medical guide for ships, WHO publication.
 - j. Pocket Guide to cold water survival IMO, London;
 - k. Guidelines for drinking water quality Vol. I Recommendations, Geneva, W. H.O;
4. Any changes in place of clinic/laboratory or assistant doctors/staff shall be reported to the Directorate within a period of 30 days.
5. List of seafarers referred to the appellate authority for re-examination shall be furnished to the Directorate within seven days along with the case history in each case.
6. List of complaints received either from the ship owners or from the seafarers shall be furnished to the Directorate within seven days along with nature of complaint.

The Directorate has the right to suspend or withdraw your approval and report such decision to the appropriate authority.
